Applicants must have a minimum of a recognized master's degree in mathematics education, recent relevant teaching experience in the Middle years and/or with Self Regulated Learning in Elementary schools in the British Columbia school system. They should have an in-depth working knowledge of the new BC curriculum, recent experience with the BC K–12 school system's structure and services, and an understanding of the various stakeholder groups and authorities involved in the provision of education in British Columbia. Duties include teaching, holding regular office hours, marking assignments, reporting grades, attending subject area meetings as well as follow-up appointments.
