- **International Masters 5-a-side Football Tournament Organization (2006-Present).** Harry is the founding Chairperson of the [International Masters 5-a-side/Futsal World Cup and Symposium](#). Harry and colleagues have implemented this grassroots international tournament (e.g., 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, 58+, 65+ small-sided game competition) for masters teams from N. America, Europe, UK, Australasia, Middle East and Africa.
- **Masters 5-a-side Football coaching (2001-Present).** Harry is the Head Coach of the [INTER UBC Masters 5v5/Futsal Research & Soccer Academy Program](#): In addition to masters football program developments and customised small-sided game structures (5v5, 4v4, 3v3, and walking football) in diverse global settings, he has led select masters teams to success in international, regional and local tournaments (including 3 times masters 5v5 world cup team winners, 4 times masters 5v5 and 3v3 world cup team runners-up, 2 times California masters team 5v5 winners, and invited games against elite masters teams from professional football clubs in UK and Europe).
