Applicants must have a minimum of a recognized master's degree in Business Education or Career Education with teaching experience within K-12 or postsecondary settings in relevant courses (e.g., economics, entrepreneurship, hospitality, marketing, and microfinance courses). We seek applicants with a vision of sustainable practices in Business Education and new ideas for educating transformative teachers. Applicants should be familiar with the British Columbia K-12 system's structure and services and with the various stakeholder groups, and with authorities involved in the provision of education in Canada. Duties include teaching, holding regular office hours, marking assignments, reporting grades, attending subject area meetings as well as follow-up appointments, where applicable.

Teaching experience within the online Canvas Learning platform will be advantageous.
