- experience in the K-12 and post-secondary education systems,
- experience with research in mathematics education at any or all of levels including elementary, secondary school and/or post-secondary.

Duties include teaching, holding regular office hours, marking assignments, reporting grades, planning with the EDCP math area coordinator, as well as follow-up appointments, where applicable.
