Applicants must have a minimum of a recognized BEd and master's degree in Technology Education or related discipline. Applicants are expected to have experience in adult education or teacher education. They should have experience in curriculum design, innovation, and teaching ADST, especially design and technology, in elementary or middle schools. Overall, they should have an in-depth working knowledge of the BC curriculum, recent experience with the K–12 school system's structure and services, and an understanding of the various stakeholder groups and authorities involved in the provision of education in BC. Duties include teaching, holding regular office hours, marking assignments, reporting grades, attending subject area meetings as well as follow-up appointments.
