Applicants must have reached doctoral candidacy with relevant teaching experience [in classroom and online] and academic expertise for undergraduate courses. Applicants should have experience in the K-12 school system, particularly with secondary Art Education, solid knowledge of contemporary art practices and socioculturally responsive art education. They should be familiar with the system's structure and services, with the various stakeholder groups and with authorities involved in the provision of education in British Columbia. Duties include teaching, holding regular online office hours, marking assignments, reporting grades, attending subject area meetings as well as follow-up appointments, where applicable.

Equity and diversity are essential to academic excellence. An open and diverse community fosters the inclusion of voices that have been under represented or discouraged. We encourage applications from members of groups that have been marginalized on any grounds enumerated under the B.C. Human Rights Code, including sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, racialization, disability, political belief, religion, marital or family status, age, and/or status as a First Nation, Metis, Inuit, or Indigenous person.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
